The Windows 11 Home to Pro upgrade primarily aims to fix with file sharing issue on Windows Home. Whereas, it also provides additional security features that were lacking in the previous version.

This guide will provide every detail that users need to know about Windows 11 Home to Pro Upgrade. First by understanding what and why the change happened and then afterwards, easy steps to walkthrough upgrade process.

System Requirements

It's important to consider that the device meets minimum requirements to smoothly upgrade on Windows 11 Pro. The basic requirements are:

- **Windows 11 Pro License**

Users need to have valid Windows 11 Pro license key which can be purchased directly from Microsoft Store or if users have product key of previous version, they can use its product key to upgrade to Windows 11 Pro.

- **Stable Internet Connectivity**

An uninterrupted internet connectivity is required to perform the upgrade for license verification and activation of Windows 11 Pro.

- **Hardware Specifications**

The users must ensure that their system meet the minimum hardware specifications such as minimum of 4GM RAM, 64GB hard disk and UEFI firmware with secure boot.

- **Backup (Recommended)**

It is recommended that before proceeding to upgrade, users must make a backup of important files either on Google drive or at any other platform.

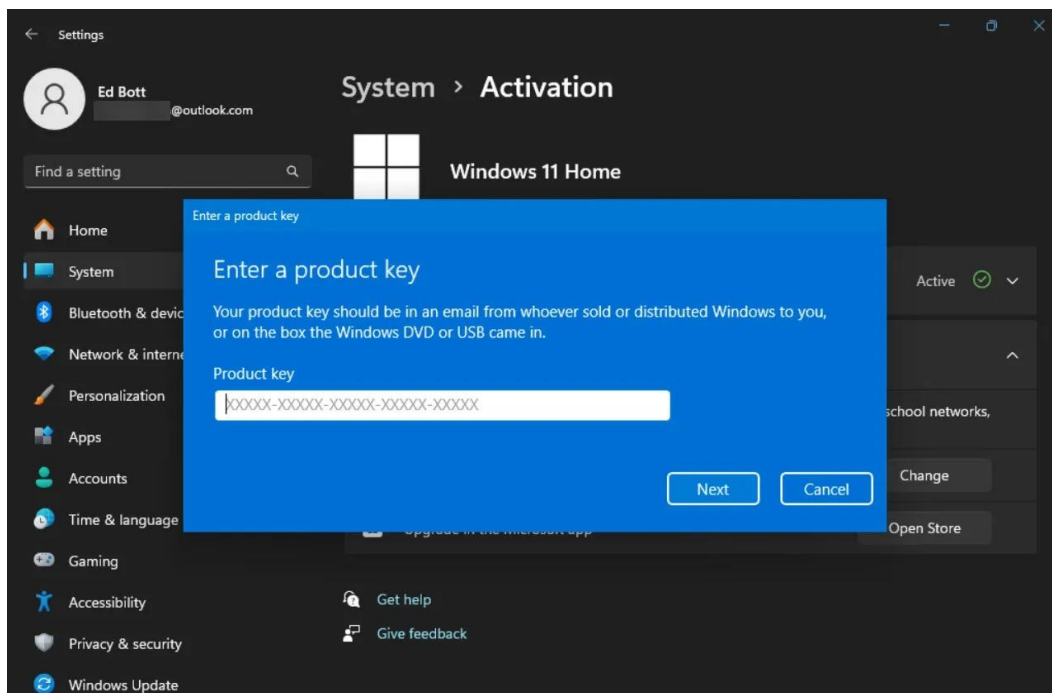
Step-by-Step Guide

The upgrading process is super easy that consists of following key steps.

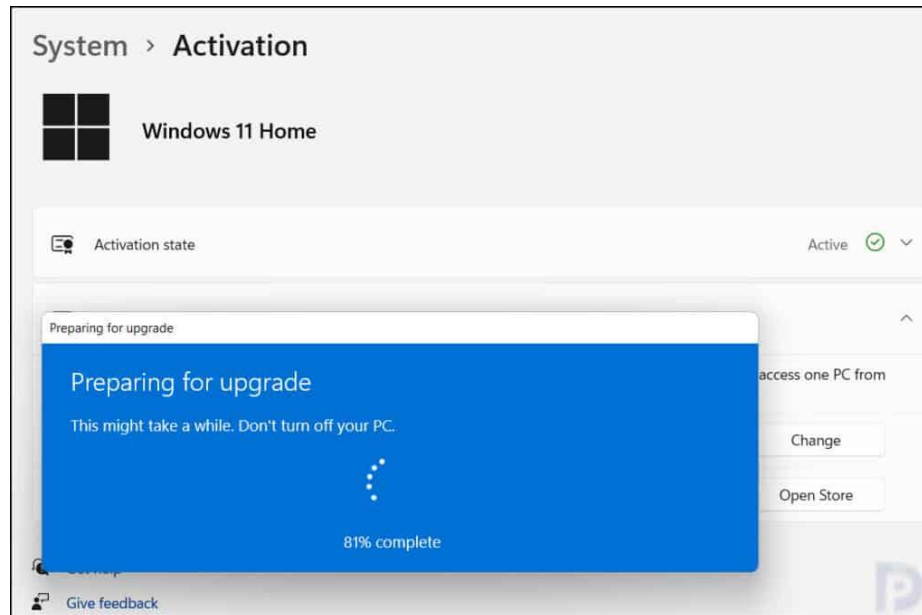
1. In the Windows 11 Home, go to Settings > System > Activation.



2. Expand the section of "Upgrade your edition of Windows" by clicking the arrow to the right of that header. Click the "Change product key" button and enter your 25-character Windows 11 Pro product key. You can buy Pro License directly from official Microsoft store from your system.



3. Once the product key has been entered, proceed with the update by following the on-screen instructions.



4. Afterwards, you'll see a multiple progress screens one by one. Once, the upgrades conclude, a success notification will appear which indicate that upgrade was successful. To verify that Windows 11 Home to Pro upgrade is currently installed on your computer and that the activation was successful, perform same steps: Settings > System > Activation.

Please note that the entire process of Windows 11 Home to Windows Pro upgrade takes approximately 20 minutes based on your hardware specifications and internet speed.

Common Questions

Can this upgrade results into loss of files or data?

No. All the files, data and application will remain as it is. However, it is recommended to create a backup of your critical data before initiating Windows 11 Home to Pro upgrade.

Is it possible to return back to previous version of Windows?

Yes. But this generally requires clean reinstallation of Windows 11 Home along with original product key.

Will upgrading fix the file sharing issue on Windows Home?

Of course. On Windows Home, the most recent Microsoft patch limited several file sharing capabilities. All network sharing features, including access to shared files, folders, and NAS devices, are restored when you upgrade to Windows 11 Pro.

Do I need admin rights to Windows 11 Home to Pro upgrade?

Yes. Before beginning the upgrade, confirm that you are logged in with an administrator account because activation settings cannot be altered by regular user accounts.
